Due to the spread of the Covid-19 virus, we are taking extra precautions to keep Fluker Farms' employees safe. Farm Action Plan *(Updated 8/2/2021)*

1. Sanitation (Personal)

- All employees must wash hands with soap for 20 seconds before shift starts and periodically throughout the day.
- Cough/sneeze in your elbow or cover your face, then wash your hands.
- Everyone is required to have a face mask (provided by Fluker's) on their person during work hours. If your workspace does not allow you to maintain a 6-foot distance from others, then you must wear your mask over your mouth and nose. You may remove mask once you are more than 6 feet away from another worker.

2. Farm Movement/Social Distancing

- Only go to areas needed to do your job. For instance, if you do not need to be in the front office or a production room, please do not go there.
- Try to keep distance (6 feet) from each other to prevent the spread of germs. This goes for truck drivers that come to deliver and pick-up, as well. Please use common sense.

3. Health

- If you have fever, you are not allowed to be at work. Please keep the well-being of your co-workers in mind.
- If you are sick, stay home and contact your manager for further direction.
- If you have been exposed to someone with a confirmed Covid-19 case, please contact your manager immediately.
- Fluker's will monitor and follow CDC recommendations and guidance as closely as possible. As we become aware of changes we will begin implementing those recommendations. www.cdc.gov

4. Vaccination
